

Promised Land Nursery

River Terrace Church deeply cares about the safety of all who visit the nursery; including staff, volunteers and children. Please read, and follow these guidelines before dropping off your little ones (ages 0-4) to play today.

~**Entering the nursery is restricted** for guardians and visitors, for the children's safety. Please remain outside the nursery and do not come behind the counter. This area is for screened and trained staff and volunteers only. You may watch all areas of the nursery through the 4 cameras that are displayed on the color monitor.

~Please use the restrooms anywhere in church to **wash children's hands** before drop off, or use the hand sanitizer on the counter. Regular and frequent handwashing of staff, volunteers and children will continue throughout the program time.

~Enjoy snack and drinks before or after the nursery. **No snack time** at this time. If your infant needs a bottle, please just let us know and we can do that.

~**Laundry:** Soft toys have been removed from the nursery. If something can be laundered, it will be washed after a single child uses it, ex: crib sheet will be removed and laundered immediately after a nap time.

~All surfaces will be wiped with **disinfectant wipes** between each program time. Disinfecting **Lysol** will be sprayed after each program time. A heavy duty **sanitizing fogger** will be used if any incident occurs where there is an exposure or possible exposure of COVID. Guardians that had children in the nursery will be **notified, through contact tracing**.

~**Occupancy ratios:** We will follow State of Michigan ratio guidelines of caregivers to child, and will not be able to accept more than the state law allows.

~All nursery attendants on staff are **fully vaccinated** at this time.

~**Masks** are to be worn when inside the building for ages 5 and up. Children ages 4 and under can wear one if they are able.

We look forward to having your child in the nursery, and hope you are able to worship in a meaningful way while they are in our care.
